

## HICKMAN MILLS FRESHMAN CENTER + SMITH-HALE MIDDLE SCHOOL

**Current: 380 students**  
**Future: 1700 students**

- Currently, the Freshman Center has an enrollment of 380 students yet has a capacity for 1700 students which will accommodate for Smith-Hale.
- Smith-Hale Middle School will move to Hickman Mills Freshman Center. The two schools will continue to act as independent facilities.
- Each school will have their own dedicated secured entries, administration offices, and media centers.
- Dedicated passing periods for each school so that grade levels will not be in the corridors at the same time.
- Santa Fe will continue acting as an independent facility.

**Future: 450 students**


- Relocate Compass Program and expand up to 450 elementary students into Baptiste.

- Consolidate Central Administration personnel to one location.






