Our goal is to provide educational, child friendly toys, books and resources to all families in the Hickman Mills community.

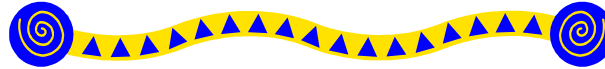
