WHAT IS IMPACT HICKMAN MILLS?

Just under 500 students were classified as homeless in the Hickman Mills C-1 School District (HMC-1) during the 2017-2018 school year. Impact Hickman Mills was created with the goal of eliminating homelessness in the district, allowing students to focus on their academic studies and education.

Impact Hickman Mills is a collective impact project between HMC-1, Avenue of Life, and Life in Full Transformation, Inc. (LIFT, Inc.). LIFT, Inc. is a 501(c)3 organization located at Blue Hills Church, and the backbone of the project.

The Impact model allows for families to receive multiple services in one day through the collaboration of varied service providers in a single location. These providers offer targeted, wrap-around care. During the Covid-19 pandemic, services continue through Zoom meetings and phone contact.

Families of students referred through the district McKinney-Vento liaison are able to meet with multiple agencies regarding housing, IDs/birth certificates, employment, healthcare, mental health, childcare, emergency relief, and other services in one place or during a specific time period on a regular basis.

Services also include community education to equip families with the tools to be sustainable and independent.

HOW TO VOLUNTEER

In addition to giving donations, volunteers are needed to:

- Sort and inventory donated items
- · Organize donated items on shelves
- Set-up and clean-up on days when clients receive services. (On designated Tuesdays between 8:30 am –12:30 pm)
